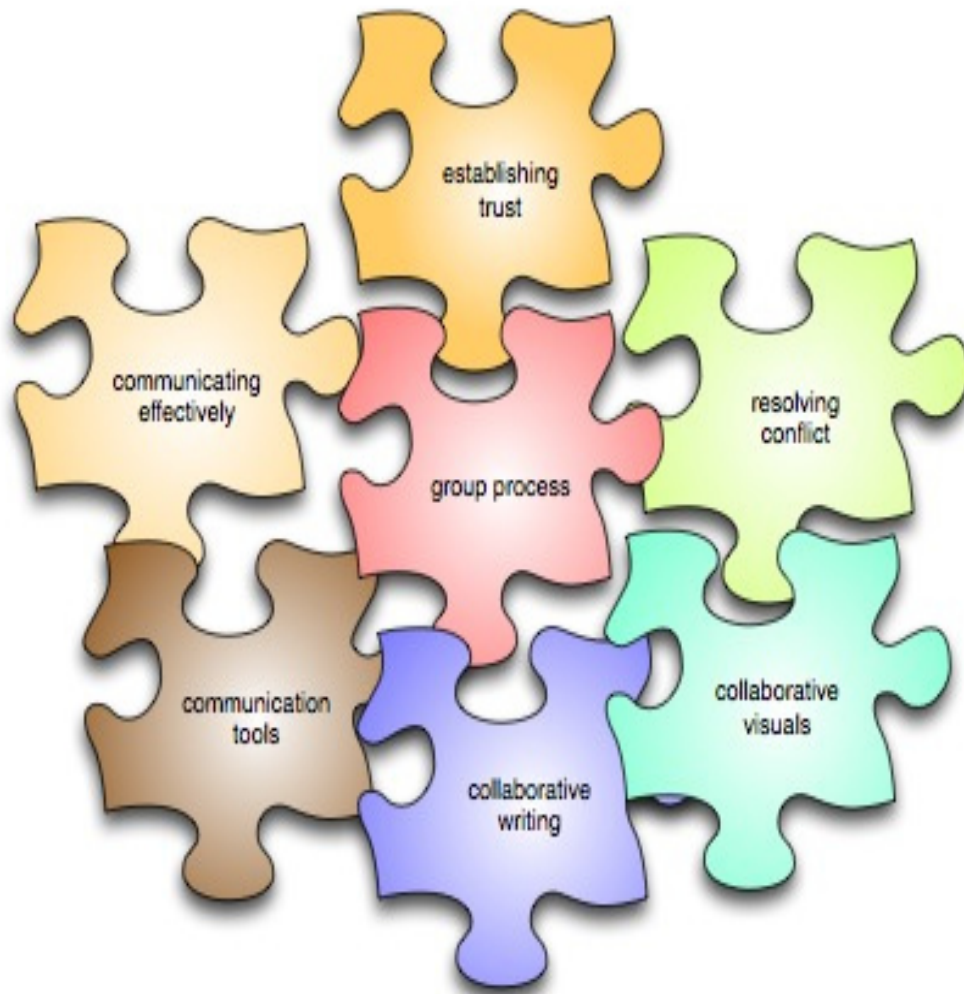

Buzzword

- Online word processor
- Multiple languages
- Allows users to write from multiple locations, often on different computers
 - > Unknown author document sharing
- Write together with colleagues
- Share work with reviewers
- Produce and share a quality document

Connect Now

- Meet live over the web
- Screen sharing
- Chat
- Notes
- Audio and video to conduct meetings online that can be as interactive and productive as in-person meetings with up to 3 participants
- No archiving available

Google Docs

Documents designed to enable anyone who accesses it to contribute or modify content

- Online word processor
- Online spreadsheet
- Online presentation tool
- Online forms / surveys
- Online calendar

Wikis

a page or collection of Web pages designed to enable anyone who accesses it to contribute or modify content, often used to create collaborative websites and to power community websites.

Single Hosted Connect Pro License

*\$450 one time setup fee
\$150 / year for hosted access license*

This hosted access license gives an individual the ability to push as much content as they want to Adobe's hosted servers.

- Host License
- Webinar Room
- Voice, Video
- Screen Sharing by any participant
- Ability to share documents [such as PPT] saved on a local machine
- Ability to walk participants through the use of a website or software programs installed on host's computer
- Participants use text box to interact with host.
- Host has option to allow participants to use voice
- Unlimited audience- only limited by server capacity
- Upload Content to server
- Record and archive meeting, which will be available for online viewing
- Share Content via web link to people who were unable to participate in meeting
- Content viewable for unlimited amount of time
